Tuesday

- Write the numbers 1-15
- Choose any three words from the "an" family. Write a sentence for each.
- Word segmenting
Ask your child to say each sound in a word.
Example: dog: d-o-g
Try these words, bag, can, lap, tag
This is necessary for reading and spelling!

Wednesday

- Practice "Which one is different?".** Parent: say three words, two that begin with the same sound and one that does not: Student: says the word that does not belong. Continue three or four times.
- Practice number flashcards 1-30
 - Write numbers 15-30
 - Complete additional worksheets if attached.

Thursday

- Review your sight word cards. Pick 3 and write them 3 times each.
- Complete your Nn picture. Draw yourself catching something in the net!
