### Monday

- Word family of the week - og  
Practice writing words that end with -dog, fog, hog, jog, log, cog, mog and so on ("Nonsense" words too!) Write each word twice.
- This weeks sentence starter is  
"We have a \_\_\_\_\_."
- Keep practicing letters and sounds to help with spelling and reading! At this time, all students should know all their letters and sounds!
- Work on your Decodable book (White paper book) homework each night.

### Tuesday

- Write the numbers 1-15
- Choose any three words from the "og" family. Write a sentence for each.
- Word segmenting  
Ask your child to say each sound in a word.  
Example: dog: d-o-g  
Try these words, tap, can, sit, ran  
This is necessary for reading and spelling!

### Wednesday

- Practice "Which one is different?" Parent: say three words, two that begin with the same sound and one that does not: Student: says the word that does not belong. Continue three or four times.
- Practice number flashcards 1-30
  - Write numbers 15-30
  - Complete additional worksheets if attached.
  - Pick one activity from our purple 2<sup>nd</sup> trimester sheet!

### Thursday

- Review your sight word cards. Pick 3 and write them 3 times each.
- Complete your Oo Picture. Draw yourself on or off something. Example: a picture of yourself on a couch then off the couch.
- Homework folders due tomorrow!

### Play opposites
