Monday

- Word family of the week - op

Practice writing words that end with -hop, top, slop, mop, gop, sop, lop ("Nonsense" words too!) Write each word twice.

- This weeks sentence starter is
"You are _____."

Challenge: learn to spell the words **you** and **are**

- Keep practicing letters and sounds to help with spelling and reading!
- Work on your Decodable book (White paper book) homework each night.

Tuesday

- Write the numbers 1-15
- Choose any three words from the "op" family. Write a sentence for each.
- Word segmenting
Ask your child to say each sound in a word.
Example: dog: d-o-g
Try these words, hit, rim, fix, dip
This is necessary for reading and spelling!

Are your Valentine cards ready? It will take a while to sign your name on 22 cards.

Wednesday- Bring Valentine Box tomorrow with cards!

Practice "Ending sounds" Parent: say a word.
Child- gives the last sound they hear in that word.
Continue to practice this skill daily. This skill will be tested for the next report card.
