### Tuesday

- Continue practicing writing your name.
- Practice sounds of letters A-Z. Keep a list of the ones you missed. And check off as you learn them!
- -Please place in homework folder.
- Predictions: Read a story and ask questions about it. *Stop periodically and ask your child to make a prediction of what will happen next.*

### Wednesday

- Can you make a list of words that start with G? How many words on your list?
- Grab 10 toys in your room.
  - Sort them by size, color and shape!
  - tell what sound and letter each toy begins with.
- Complete additional worksheets.

### Thursday

Review your sight word cards, he, she, small, have, it, no and this.

- Complete you're My Gg thing in My Garage. Draw a colorful picture of an item that starts with G. ALSO write a sentence I see a \_\_\_\_\_.
