## Scholarship Application

The Shivela Middle School Parent Teacher Student Association wants to continue the tradition of supporting our students – both present and past students. Annually, the Shivela Middle School PTSA offers a one-time scholarship to graduating high school students who have attended Shivela Middle School for at least one entire school year (grades 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>). This year the PTSA will award three (3) scholarships to qualified students in the amount of \$500.00 each. Deadline for application submission is **May 2, 2016**. Students will be notified of scholarship award on or before **June 1, 2016**.

### Scholarship Criteria:

- Must be a graduating high school senior for the 2015-16 school year
- Must currently attend a high school in the Murrieta Valley Unified School District
- Must have attended Shivela Middle School at least two full school year during middle school (grades 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and/or 8<sup>th</sup>)
- Must have been a member of the Shivela Middle School PTSA during the year(s) of attendance
- Students who have never attended Shivela Middle School are not eligible for the scholarship – ineligible applications will not be reviewed
- Students who submit an application with false information will not be awarded scholarship funds and will be disqualified
- Application must be complete – incomplete applications/missing information will not be considered for review
- Applications must be submitted by **May 2, 2016**. Applications submitted after this date will not be considered for review
- Responses to the discussion questions will be judged on composition, content, clarity, and grammar
- Applications may be dropped off at Shivela Middle School - PTSA on campus correspondence box or mailed to Shivela Middle School, Attn: PTSA Scholarship/Mrs. Williams, 24515 Lincoln Avenue, Murrieta, CA 92562 (delivery confirmation is recommended) - **Do NOT** submit applications via email
