The Virginia Plan called for **two houses** of Congress. Representation in each house would be determined by **population**.

The New Jersey Plan called for a **single house** of Congress. Each state would have an **equal** vote.

10. Read "Resolution: The Great Compromise" and complete the task below.

What compromise did the delegates create to resolve the issue of state representation?

The Great Compromise called for **two houses** of Congress. In the first house, the **House of Representatives**, representation would be based on population.

In the second house, the **Senate**, each state would have **two senators** elected by the state legislatures.
