Baseball Recreational Camp

WHEN: Our annual summer camp will begin Monday July 7th and will run until Thursday July 24th. Camp will run three weeks, Monday through Thursday. (July 4th is a Holiday) Camp times will be from 9:00am to 11:00am.

WHERE: Camp will take place at the Murrieta Valley High School varsity baseball field.

FEE*: 175.00 per student athlete, includes Murrieta Valley baseball shirt and hat.

Deadline: Tuition should be paid online through the link on our athletics' website (<http://www.murrieta.k12.ca.us//Domain/1636>) or directly to the Murrieta Valley's bookkeeper on or before July 1st. The baseball team is a school sponsored group and no student will be denied the opportunity to participate due to the inability to purchase a uniform or attend summer camp. Scholarships are available.

What will be taking place:

Our camp is designed to help your player improve their individual and team skills, conditioning and overall proficiency in the game. Summer camp is not mandatory, but is strongly encouraged for coaching, learning, personal improvement and bonding as a team.

PHYSICALS & WAIVERS: Each player must have a current physical. A student can have her own physician conduct the physical. Student athletes need to take the MVHS physical forms with them and have it completed by your physician. The form can be downloaded from the Murrieta Valley High School's athletic website (<http://www.murrieta.k12.ca.us//Domain/1636>). Physical Forms must be performed by a M.D. We cannot accept physicals from a Chiropractor, Dentist or Physician Assistant. Students must have a completed athletic participation packet to participate in athletics at Murrieta Valley High School.
