Conjugations for 'ser'

yo soy

nosotros somos

tú eres

x

él/ella/usted es

ustedes son
ellos

'ser' examples

- # (time) *Son las 3 de la tarde.*
- # (origin) *Yo soy de México.*
- # (profession) *Nosotros somos maestros.*
- # (identification) *Es un gato feo.*
- # (characteristics) *Ellos son serios.
& Tú eres feo.*

Conjugations of 'estar '

To remember the verb *estar*
remember the acronym:
P.L.A.C.E

- # Position
- # Location
- # Action
- # Condition
- # Emotion



;'estar' examples

- # (Position) Ana está afuera. (outside)
- # (Location) Target está en Murrieta.
- # (Action) Yo estoy hablando.
- # (Condition) Ustedes están enfermos.(sick)
- # (Emotion) Tú estás contenta.

Let's check.. ser or estar ?

- # I am smart.
- # We are at school.
- # The store is in San Diego.
- # She is sick.
- # They are skinny and tall.
