Contest Guidelines:

- Must include our school name Alta Murrieta Elementary School and the year 2016-2017.
- Incorporate this year's theme "Alta Rocks" and/or "Be Nice". Include school colors and our school mascot, the Mustang.
- All artwork MUST be turned in to your teacher on or before **Wednesday, December 14th** to be considered for the contest.
- Art work must be turned in on white, unlined 8.5" x 11" paper in portrait orientation.
- Student's name must be written on the back lightly in pencil; permission slip must be filled out and turned in with artwork. (NO STAPLES).
- Be creative, be neat, do your best, and have fun!

Tips to creating a picture-perfect design:

- **Rich Colors** - The more depth and contrast in your artwork, the better! Dark colors placed next to each other will not reproduce well. Bright, bold colors are best.
- **Thick Lines** - make sure outlines are thick. Use a Sharpie/markers to outline.
- **Careful with Crayons** - If using crayons, be sure the color is crisp and not too subtle. Light shading with crayons or colored pencils may not reproduce.
- **Metallics and Fluorescents** - Glitter, metallic, and fluorescent colors do not reproduce well when printed and should be avoided.
