



Bronco Wrestling Varsity Letter Requirements

LETTER AWARDS

Vista Murrieta High School will issue one letter per student, per athletic career, which is only to be worn on an official letter jacket. Each additional time a wrestler letters, he will receive a certificate (second, third, or fourth year,) and a chevron. All wrestlers must follow scholastic, citizenship, and training rules set forth by Vista Murrieta High School and the wrestling program.

REQUIREMENTS USED TO LETTER VARSITY WRESTLERS:

A Varsity Wrestling letter will be awarded to any wrestler who meets one of the qualifications outlined below and finishes the year in good standing with the coaches, team, Athletic Director, and the School Administration.

A.

1. Finish the season in good standing
2. Maintain a minimum of a 2.0 GPA
3. Compete as a varsity starter in more than half of the varsity tournaments and dual meets
4. Be a model of C.L.A.S.S. both on campus and in the community
5. Volunteer during Bronco Kids Wrestling Club practices and tournaments
6. Coaches recommendation for the varsity letter

B. A Senior Wrestler who has been a member of the program for 4 full seasons and has not met varsity requirements may letter if the coaches feel they have earned the letter through their dedication, work ethic, and service to the school and team.

C. Due to injury, illness, or other circumstances, an athlete who in the coach's estimation would have lettered may receive a letter.
