

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR FIRST-TIME FRESHMEN

CSUDH IS NOT AN IMPACTED CAMPUS

Requirements at a Glance

To qualify for admission to CSUDH, a firsttime freshman must:

- ✓ Be a high school graduate
- ✓ Have a qualifiable <u>eligibility index</u>
- ✓ Have completed with grades of "C" or better each of the courses in the comprehensive pattern of college preparatory <u>subject requirements</u>. Courses must be completed prior to the first enrollment in the California State University.

October 1-November 30 Priority application filing period

February 15 Missing application documents deadline

Deadline line to submit Intent to Enroll at My.CSUDH.EDU Enrollment deposit is not required

May 2 Deadline to take the EPT/ELM test

Deadline to submit official high school transcript showing date of graduation

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR UPPER DIVISION TRANSFER STUDENTS

CSUDH IS NOT AN IMPACTED CAMPUS

Requirements at a Glance

- 1. Have completed 60 transferable semester units (90 quarter units)
- 2. Have completed at least 30 semester (45 quarter) units of general education courses, graded C or better in each course including the "The Golden Four:
 - One Written Communication course
 - One Oral Communication
 - One Critical Thinking/Logic course
 - One Mathematics/quantitative reasoning with intermediate algebra as prerequisite.
- 3. Have a grade point average of 2.00 or better in all transferable college units attempted
- 4. Be in good standing at the last college or university attended (i.e. eligible to re–enroll at that college or university).
