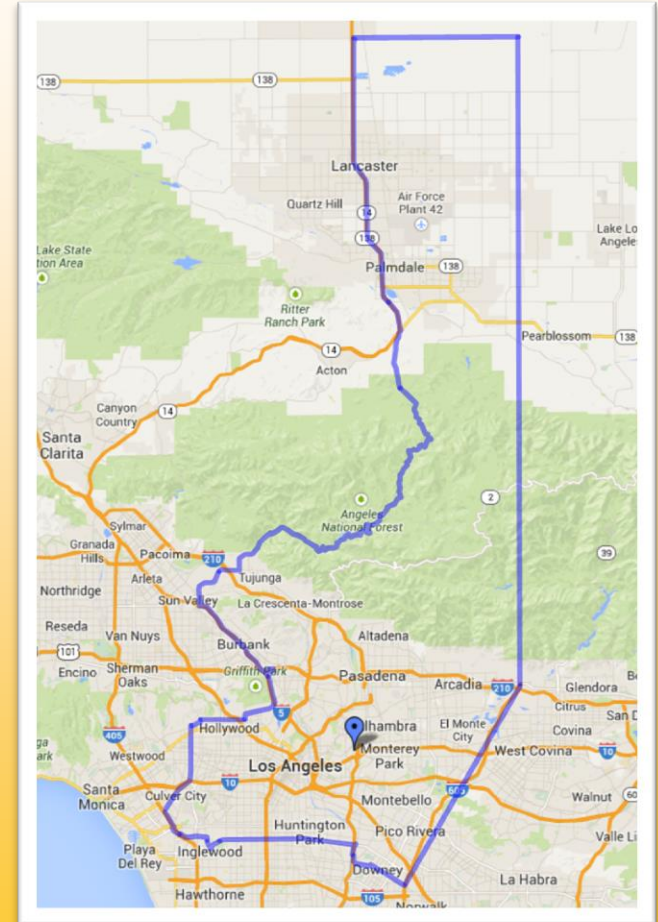

  - Enrollment Confirmation Deposit (\$100) –  
**May 1, 2015**
  - Final transcripts – **July 15, 2015**
    - Must include Spring 2015 courses and grades

## President's Scholars

- \$2,500-\$10,000/year
- Minimum requirements:
  - Incoming first time Freshmen
  - 3.75 High School CSU GPA
  - 1200 SAT (Critical Reading & Math only) or 27 ACT Composite
- Qualify for CSU college-level Math & English

## Honors College Scholars

- \$2,000/year
- Minimum requirements:
  - Incoming first time Freshmen
  - 3.50 High School CSU GPA
  - 1100 SAT (Critical Reading & Math only) or 26 ACT Composite

## Osher Scholarships

- California Community College transfer students
- Demonstrate financial need
- Show academic promise and a commitment to obtaining a baccalaureate degree

## Other General Scholarships

- Over 1,000 scholarships available
- Award amount varies
- One general scholarship application required per year
