# **FALL 2014 FRESHMAN OVERVIEW**

Total Applications = 12,862

Total Admitted = 8,212

- Average GPA = 3.24
- Average SAT combined Math and Verbal score for admitted students = 948
- Average ACT composite Math and Verbal score for admitted students = 19.8
- Acceptance email notifications began in Dec. for LAA and Feb. for Non-LAA
- Non-LAA index was 3300 SAT and 783 ACT

# **IMPACTED PROGRAMS**

- Selection of major does not impact the admission decision
- Students are admitted in "pre-major" status
- Separate screening criteria within each major are used to allow students to declare these majors after students have been admitted.

### **AA/AS-T DEGREE PROGRAMS**

- Local admissions area admitted with minimum eligibility requirements:
  - > 60 units
  - > 4 basic subjects
  - > 2.0 GPA
- Non-local admissions area applicants will receive a .2 increase in cumulative GPA for non-impacted majors and a .1 increase for impacted majors for the purpose of admissions evaluation
