



## **Grandma Apple Cake**

**By Celine Cuisine Local Cooking Instructor and cookbook author**

### **INGREDIENTS**

#### **Cake**

- 4 apples
- 1.5 Cup of all-purpose flour
- 1.5 Cup caster sugar
- 2 eggs
- 2 tsp Vanilla extract
- 1 lemon
- 3.5 Tbsp of butter
- 10 Tbsp of milk
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 1 pinch of salt

#### **Topping**

- 1 cup of sugar
- 1/3 cup of butter
- 1 egg

1. Preheat oven to 350 F
2. Greased and floured round pan cake.
3. Peel and seed the apples. Cut two apples into small pieces and sliced thinly the other two apples. Sprinkle them with lemon juice and set aside. Melt the butter in microwave or in a saucepan. Sift the flour with the baking powder into a bowl. Whisk the eggs and vanilla extract. Gradually add milk, melted butter, sugar, salt. Mix until smooth and homogeneous preparation. Add the diced apples into it. Mix well for all apples pieces to be incorporated.
4. Pour the prepared batter and arrange the remaining sliced apples on the dough. Bake for 20 minutes.
5. During this time make the topping cream: melt the butter, add the beaten egg and sugar. Mix vigorously together and set aside.
6. After 20 minutes baking, open the oven and pour the cream on the cake and bake for 30 minutes until golden brown
