
### We Need Your Help in the Parking Lot

### Positive Behavioral Supports Moment

The Buchanan family has always been a strong community of parents, teachers, and others that have worked together to assist all Blazer students in becoming the best scholars they can be while also being productive members of their future communities. This year we look to continue this tradition while taking additional steps for further student growth.



Like last year we will focus on teaching and re-teaching the universal expectations of being respectful, being responsible, and being safe throughout the year. Every area of campus; from the hallways, to the MPR, to the playground and to the bathrooms; will have posters highlighting the expectations in those areas.

Additionally, this year we will also teach social skills specific to school, but can be applied to life outside of school. During Friday Spirit Assemblies and in classrooms students will be given step by step cues for how to handle different situations that may come up as they go from elementary school, to middle school, and then on to high school and beyond. Be ready to ask your student or students what it looks like to follow instructions, to stay on task, and even how to accept criticism appropriately. Yes, our goal is to produce students that can read and write and do arithmetic, but we also want to produce well rounded students that 'blaze the trail' to their own futures.
