## **Counselor's Corner**

## How To Survive Summer Break

Parents have a love/hate relationship with summer. They are excited to have their children home more, excited to not have so many responsibilities (places to be), but may feel anxious about all the time that will need to be filled.

There are lots of resources and ideas for activities and things to do during the summer months, but here are some general thoughts to help ease the anxiety that might be threatening your summer fun.

- Allow your family to have down time. It is not necessary to schedule every minute. It may be nice to not to have so many places to be.
- **Don't abandon routine.** As nice as down time is, a completely unstructured summer may lead to boredom or chaos in the house. Stick to chores and responsibilities that are appropriate for their ages and abilities and be sure those things are taken care of each day.
- **Consider service.** One of the best things we can do for our children, is teach them the importance of serving and helping others. While you are planning your summer activities, include some service oriented activities.
- **Plan ahead.** Take a few minutes to do some research about all the fun things your city has to offer over the next few months. Most places you will want to visit, do promotions, two for one days, kids free days etc... These are good things to know in advance and great to put on the calendar. That way, you have planned ahead and saved money too.
- Ask for input. Ask your children what they want to do this summer. They have been dreaming about it too! They are certain to have opinions, and including them will help them feel in control and assume ownership over their actions throughout the next few months. They will also be much more likely to take care of their chores and responsibilities when they know they are getting to participate in things they are excited about, because they helped choose them.
- **Regulate technology time early.** Don't let technology get the best of your family. Set your time guidelines BEFORE the summer gets under way. This way, the children will understand the summer routine before arguments arise.
- **Don't forget the books!** One of the best activities for your children to be involved in over the next few months, is continued reading. It will help them retain what they learned in school, and keep their minds and imaginations sharp.
- **Team up with other parents.** Your children's friends may have additional ideas of activities to do and may be happy to include your children.
- **Schedule "Me Time".** Make sure you take care of your own need for a break by planning ways you can do the things you like to do. This will help revitalize you.
- Love them. Instead of thinking about how stressful it might be to entertain your children over the next few months, ake the time to get to know them, talk to them more, laugh with them more, and share more experiences with them.

### Procedure For Teacher Assignment Notification for the 2016-2017 School Year

Teacher assignment notification for the 2016-2017 school year for all students in grades Transitional Kindergarten thru 5th grade will take place August 2nd thru August 4th during the hours of 9am-1pm.

Please visit our school website at murrieta.k12.ca.us/buchanan for information on when the Parent Portal will open. Once the portal opens, you will go in and verify or make changes to all the data information. An automated phone call will also be sent out when the parent portal opens, so make sure the office has your current phone number on file. <u>All data must be updated and a current utility bill in the parents name dated June or July presented</u> to receive your child's teacher assignment. During August 2nd - 4th registration, you will complete a health information form and we will verify the utility bill and that the data confirmation in the parent portal is complete. Once we verify that everything has been completed, you will receive your child's teacher assignment for the school year.

Parents are <u>highly encouraged</u> to complete the above information prior to August 4<sup>th.</sup> Waiting until the last moment will result in long lines and possibly delay your student starting school on August 10th. We also <u>highly encourage</u> those of you with new students to Buchanan Elementary to enroll your child beginning Monday, July 25, 2016 thru Friday, August 5, 2016 when our office reopens from the summer break.
