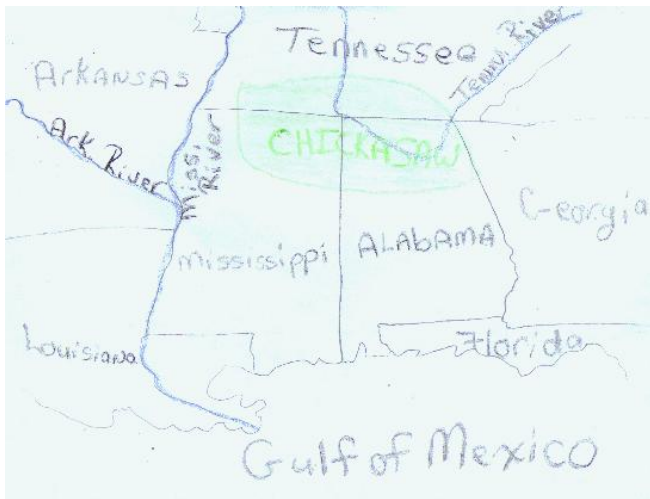


🏞️ The Chickasaw Tribe 🏞️
