Daily Life

The Kwakiutl men hunted for deer and moose, but their main food was fish. The women's diet was shellfish, seaweed, and berries. Large canoes were also used as camps.



There were about 30 groups, mostly in the north. Each group had a chief. In the 18th century, explorers from Europe came and were looking for Pacific coast people.

The Kwakiutl loved to play flutes. The Kwakiutl's best flute was called the style flute. The Kwakiutl had canoes to go hunting. Their main food was fish, but they also ate squid.

The Kwakiutl lived on the coast of British Columbia and the northern tip of Vancouver Island. The Kwakiutl lived in long rectangular plank houses.
