1. basked: rested in a pleasant place
2. buffeted: struck against powerfully; blown about
3. horizon: the line where the sky seems to meet the sea
4. quay: a dock where ships are loaded and unloaded
5. surf: to ride on waves, often on a surfboard
6. swell: a long, large wave that moves along without breaking
7. swooped: moved with a sudden, sweeping motion
8. elated: very happy
9. panic: to feel sudden fear
10. reflection: a picture made by a mirror or smooth water
