## What Is the Murrieta High Schools' Scholarship Foundation?



The Murrieta High Schools' Scholarship Foundation, chartered in 1993, is a local chapter of Dollars for Scholars and Scholarship America, a non-profit corporation. The purpose of the foundation is to assist Murrieta seniors by providing scholarships for continued education after high school graduation. The Foundation raises money for scholarships, supervises the application process and manages scholarship money.

Students may be eligible to receive Dollars for Scholars chapter and other Scholarship America-related scholarships that can be used to fill any unmet student need remaining after the institution's financial aid package has been calculated.

Scholarship America has both Collegiate Partners® and Matching Partners. Collegiate Partners® are colleges, universities and other accredited postsecondary institutions that demonstrate their commitment to the development of private sector student aid by supporting the mission of Scholarship America® and its Dollars for Scholars® program.

Matching Partners are Collegiate Partners that make further commitments to undergraduate students who have unmet need by agreeing to match scholarship awards coming to their campuses from Dollars for Scholars chapters and/or Scholarship America-related programs.

### Becoming a Donor?

Any person, family, business or organization can become a donor. The Foundation gladly accepts donations in any amount. Scholarships are awarded in minimum increments of \$250.00 so only scholarships of \$250.00 or more may be awarded in the name of the donor.

### Annual Scholarships:

A yearly scholarship given by a person, family, business or organization. Although the amount may vary, the minimum donation is \$250.00.

### Memorial Scholarships:

A scholarship given in honor or memory of an individual. These may be given one year or annually. The minimum donation is \$250.00.

### Endowment Fund Scholarships:

Donations are given to be invested with a principal sum and the interest is issued for scholarship awards. NO minimum donation is required; however, to be awarded in a specific name, the accumulated annual interest must total a minimum of \$250.00. Smaller contributions will be pooled in the MHSSF Endowment Fund.

### Foundation Scholarships:

These scholarships are formed from the pool of less than \$250.00 donations received during the year. They are awarded in various amounts in the Foundation's name.

### How are the Funds Managed?

All funds are kept in a fully-insured local bank. Scholarships are sent directly to accredited schools upon proof of student enrollment. No monies are given directly to any students.

### Who is Eligible for Scholarships?

All graduating seniors from the Murrieta Valley Unified School District with a cumulative grade point average from 9th through 12th grade of **3.5** or better are eligible. Students must complete an application, an essay and obtain two letters of recommendation. Applicants are also evaluated on their extra curricular involvement and community service.



### How are Scholarship Recipients Selected?

Donors of \$250.00 or more may choose to evaluate applicants and select a recipient or they may have the Foundation choose their recipient. Appointments are scheduled in March for donors to screen applicants. The Foundation Selection Committee reviews all applications and selects recipients for Foundation scholarships.

### Scholarship Presentations:

The Scholarship Foundation awards will be presented on April 30, 2012 at an evening ceremony at Revival Christian Fellowship, 29220 Scott Road, Menifee.
