C. EDUCATIONAL SERVICES

C.1 California Assessment of Student Performance & Progress Results

Pam Wilson, Assistant Superintendent; Mary Walters, Executive Director of Secondary Education; and Faythe Mutchnick-Jayx, Executive Director of Elementary Education reviewed results of the 2015 California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) in English and math. It was reported that student participation rates exceeded 96% and overall performance exceeded initial expectations. Mrs. Wilson stated that these scores will serve as the new baseline, and staff will actively monitor and address achievement gaps with targeted subgroups.
