

HOW TO CREATE A FSA ID

STUDENTS AND PARENTS WITH A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER SHOULD CREATE AN FSA ID. MAKE SURE TO SAVE YOUR LOGIN INFO BECAUSE YOU NEED TO SUBMIT THE FAFSA EVERY YEAR THAT YOU WILL BE RETURNING TO COLLEGE!

- STEP 1: GO TO FSAID.GOV AND CREATE A USERNAME AND PASSWORD
- STEP 2: ENTER IN YOUR NAME, DATE OF BIRTH, AND SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER
- STEP 3: ENTER IN YOUR PERSONAL EMAIL, PHONE NUMBER, AND MAILING ADDRESS
- STEP 4: SELECT YOUR CHALLENGE QUESTIONS AND INPUT YOUR ANSWERS
- STEP 5: REVIEW AND CONFIRM YOUR INFORMATION IS CORRECT
- STEP 6: VERIFY YOUR PHONE NUMBER AND EMAIL IF AVAILABLE
- STEP 7: YOUR FSA ID HAS BEEN CREATED! SAVE YOUR INFORMATION BECAUSE YOU NEED IT EVERY YEAR TO APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID
