MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Greetings, Bronco Families!

We are proud to announce that Vista Murrieta High School has been recognized as a California Distinguished School. Schools were selected by analyzing data reported through the 2023 Dashboard, with a focus on demonstrating excellence and growth in academic achievement and ensuring a positive school climate. Schools are recognized for exceptional student performance based on achieving exemplary performance in English Language Arts (ELA) and math, reducing suspensions, and demonstrating high graduation rates (high schools only). Schools recognized for closing the achievement gap enroll at least 40 percent of their students from socioeconomically disadvantaged backgrounds and, in addition to demonstrating exemplary overall performance in ELA and math, achieve accelerated academic growth for one or more historically underserved student groups.

We are incredibly proud of this accomplishment and thank you for partnering with us to amplify ALL of our Bronco students!

We welcomed our incoming ninth grade families to The Ranch on Monday night. Traditionally, the program has been facilitated by our Bronco administration, counseling and staff. This year, we asked our students to share their stories about what it means to be a Bronco. Students shared information about the respective programs and provided insight on how to be academically successful, and meaningfully engaged at VMHS.

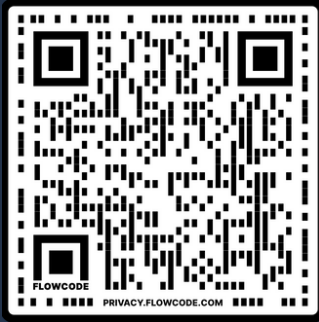
