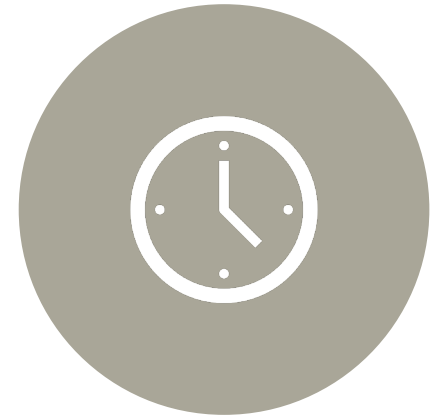

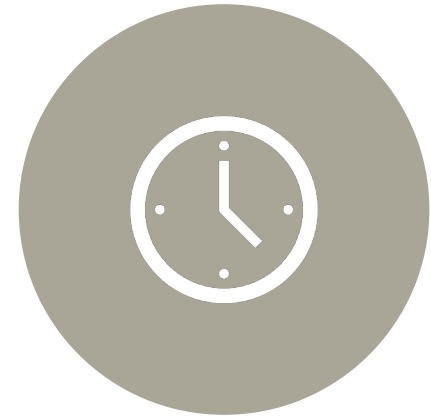

 - Students test out of being designated an EL and no longer have to take the LPAC test

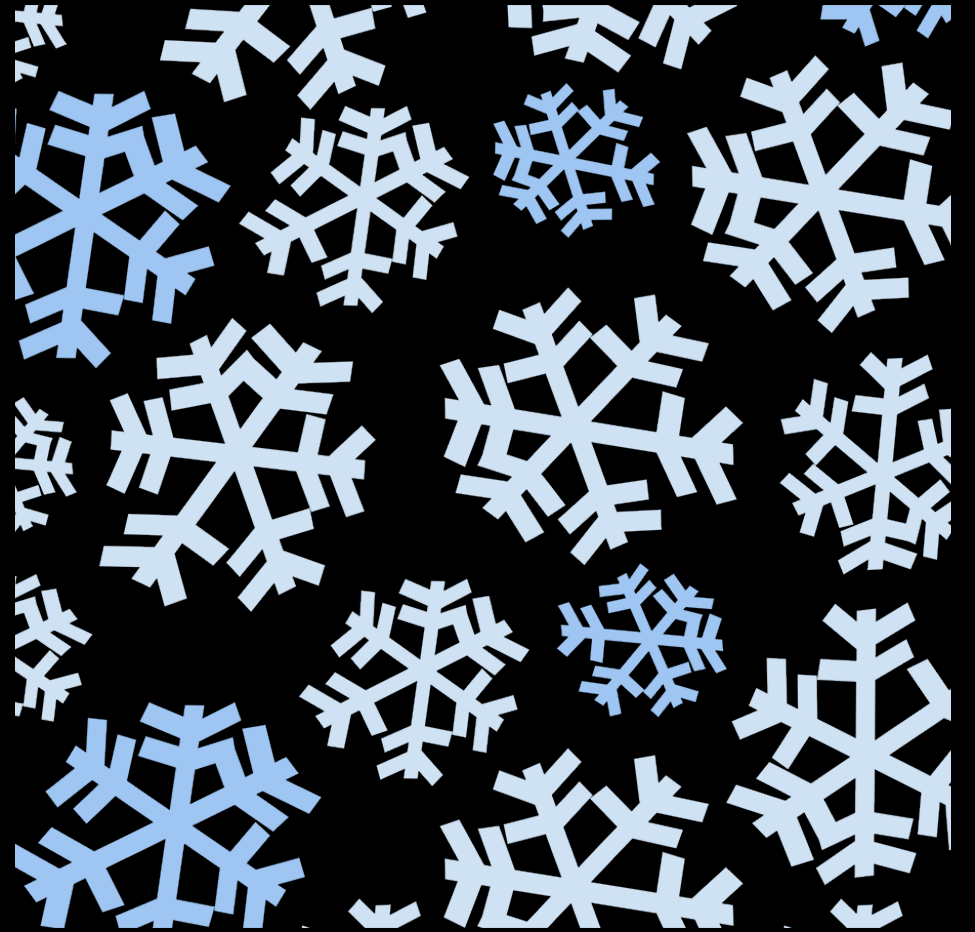

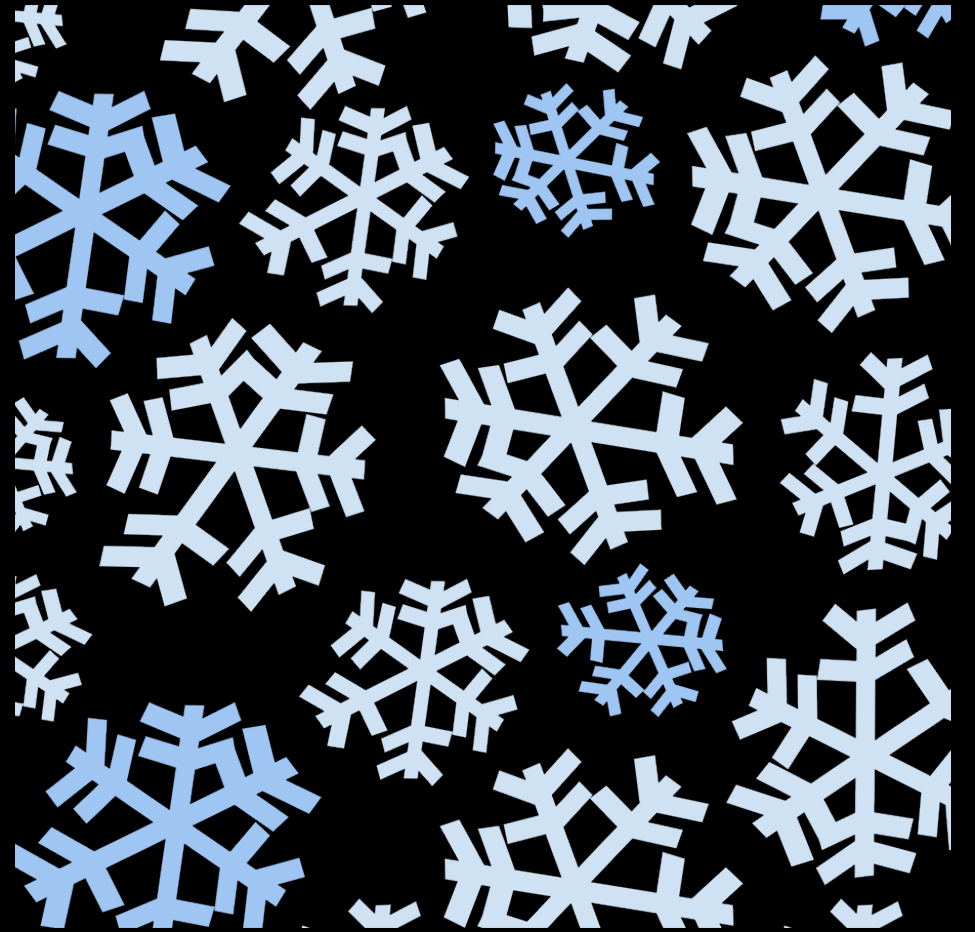


