



## **School Counseling Program Goals**



Attendance- Decrease the number of students that are chronically absent.

Academics- Decrease the number of D's & F's in core academics.

**Social**/ **Emotional**- Increase support and interventions

## Tips to Succeed in Middle School



Tips for Helping your child succeed in Middle School.

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### • Create a **schedule**

- Using & Checking Student planner daily
  - To write down important deadlines
  - Make a checklist
- Create a **study space** & plan for **2 hrs of homework**
- Help your child **prioritize** busy afternoons


### **EMBEDDED ADVANCED LANGUAGE ARTS 6**
