




District Mission Statement

- Support cultural proficiency development and equitable practice.







TIPS FOR SUCCESS!



Get a good night sleep (9-11 hours)

Set a daily schedule

Be present, pay attention, and participate during class lessons!

Be sure to take notes during lessons!

Attend Office Hours regularly

Plan for approximately 2 hours of homework each day on average.




