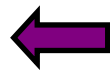

TARDY POLICY

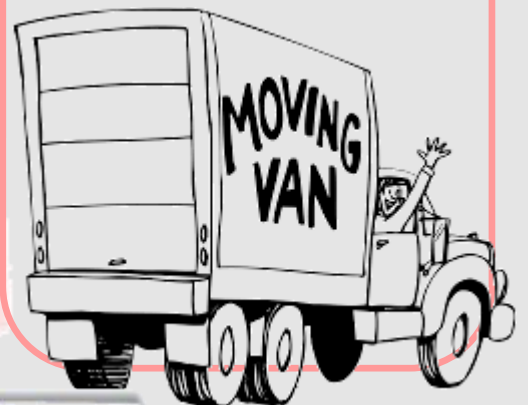

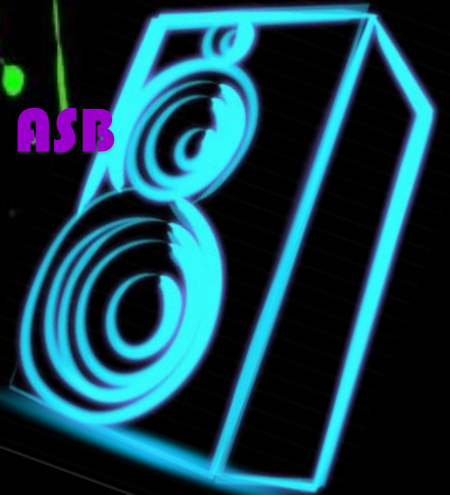

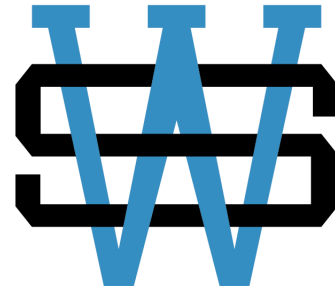
