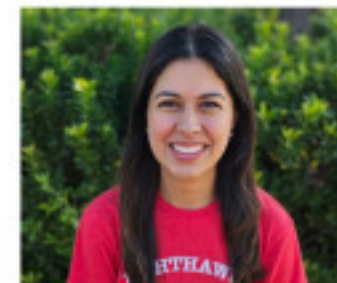

credits

Each class you pass with "D" or higher,
you earn **5** credits

5 credits X 7 classes = **35** credits a semester

35 credits + 35 credits = **70** per year

You need **230** credits to graduate from High
School

GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA)

GPA is the average of the grades earned in each course.

How can you calculate your GPA?

A=4 points

B=3 points

C=2 points

D= 1 point

F= 0 point



How to Calculate



How to Calculate GPA | 4.0 Grade Point Average Formula

weighted classes

-AP, IB, and MSJC Annex classes are weighted

-you receive an extra POINT in GPA

- "C", it gets bumped to a "B" (3.0)
- "B", it gets bumped to a "A" (4.0)
- "A", it gets bumped to a "A++" (5.0)

"D's" do not bump up

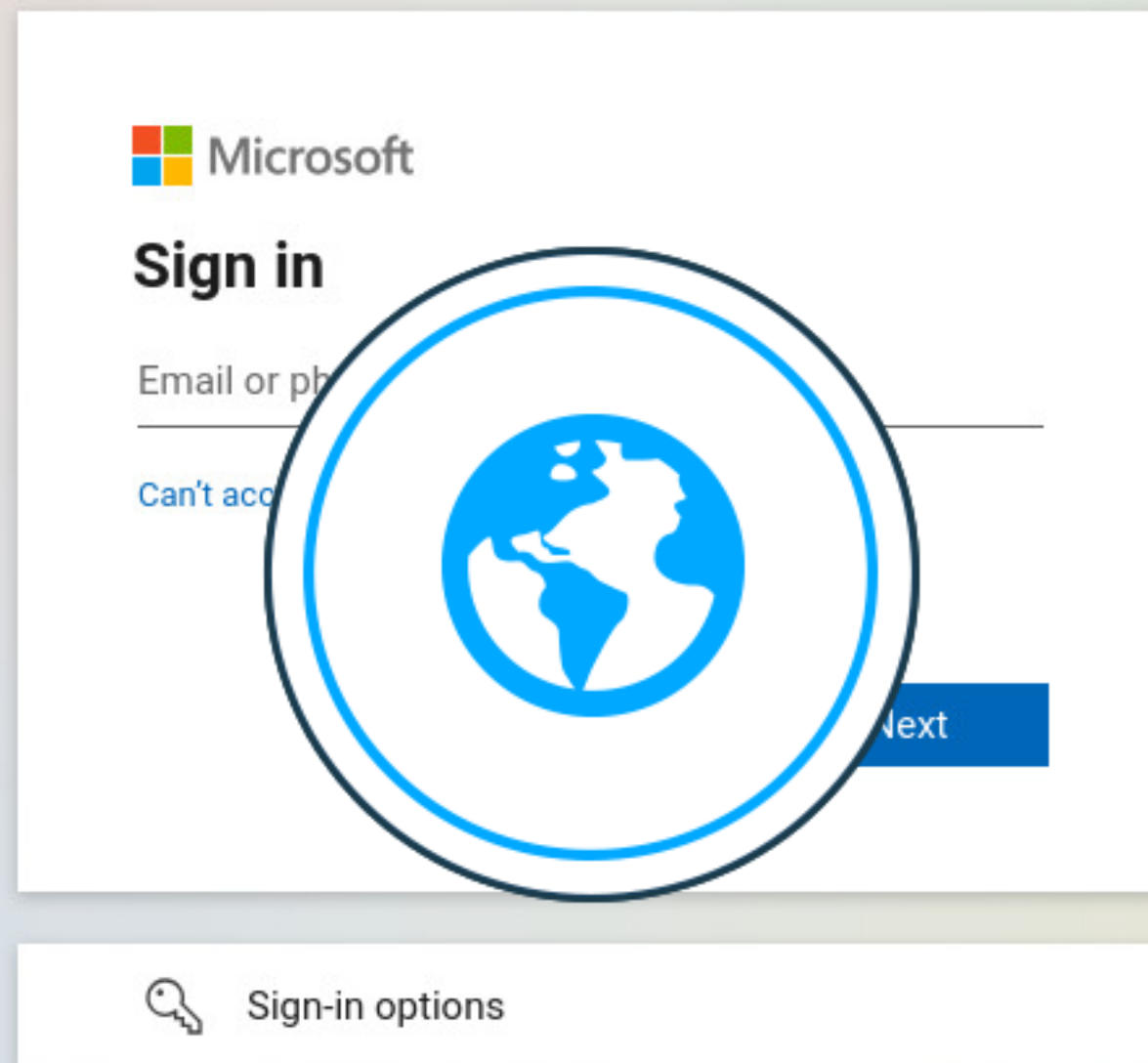
1) Why is SELF ADVOCACY important?
