We award four \$3,000 scholarships to local, female, graduating high school seniors. It is paid out in two installments (approximately July 2020 and January 2021) directly to the financial aid office at your college; \$1,500 each installment. You may use the scholarship dollars for the following expenses:

- 1. Tuition for an accredited college ortrade school for the 2020 -2021 school year
- 2. Text books
- 3. Lab fees

SPECIFIC CRITERIA: To qualify for the PWR Scholarship Program, recipients must meet all of the following criteria:

- 1. Must be alocal, female, student onpace to graduate in June 2020 at the time of submitting application.
- 2. Have community involvement
- 3. Have overcome some sort of adversity.
- 4. Have acommitment to success; whether it be college ortrade school

To Apply: Please compile the following items and submit to Lori Hoopingarner in this order:

- 1. Complete page 1 of this application.
- 2. In 1-2 typed pages, describe your most difficult challenge and how you overcame it.
- 3. In 1 typed page, give us a personal statement describing any relevant information about yourself, your community involvement, where you're planning to attend in the fall, and your educational and professional goals.
- 4. A copy of your unofficial transcript

The scholarship application packet <u>must be received</u>, at 43460 Ridge Park Drive, Suite 200, on or before 4:00 PM on Monday February 20, 2020. Any application received after this time, will NOT qualify. We are not responsible for late or undelivered mail. You can drop off the application at the front desk, or you may fax the application, but we would recommend you call to be sure the fax has been received in its entirety. Unfortunately, applications cannot be submitted via email at this time.

The Scholarship Committee may request a personal interview to assist in making their final determinations.

Finalists will be notified by telephone or email by March 20, 2020. If you are chosen for our scholarship, **we will award it at our PWR luncheon on Thursday, April 2, 2020.** The luncheon will begin at 11:15 a.m. and conclude at 1:00 p.m. You should plan to be there by 11:00 and stay until about 1:30 for pictures and mentor assignment (mentor assignment is optional).

If you are awarded our scholarship, evidence of enrollment in a college or trade school must be provided to Lori Hoopingarner, Scholarship Chair. Failure to provide Lori, in writing, of the school you have enrolled in by June 1, 2020 may result in forfeiture of your scholarship.
