- Provides specialized support during college years
- Designed to help *low-income*, first generation, historically educationally disadvantaged students succeed academically in college and graduate.
 - First Generation: neither of your parents graduated from college.

- The EOP application is built into the Cal State Apply application. Students can submit the Cal State Apply application without the EOP portion complete and come back to it.
