GENERAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

- ✓ Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., North San Diego County Alumnae Chapter, invites graduating seniors of North San Diego County and South Riverside County area high schools to apply for the NSDCAC (North San Diego County Alumnae Chapter) Scholarship. Awards of \$1,000 will be offered.
- ✓ Eligibility for this scholarship is intended for African American graduating seniors enrolled at high schools within North San Diego County and South Riverside County.
- ✓ The completed application packet must be postmarked no later than March 29, 2019.
- ✓ The completed application packet must contain the following:
 - ➤ An official high school transcript (sealed and unopened) to verify a minimum 3.0 GPA on an overall 4.0 GPA scale.
 - > Demonstrated record of extracurricular activities in leadership and community service.
 - > Three (3) letters of recommendation, i.e. school administrators, counselors, teachers, community leader, employer, etc.
 - Acknowledged need of financial assistance based on current family income.
 - One (1) page, typed essay, 12-point font, doubled-spaced, standard margins addressing the application's prompt found on the last page of the scholarship application.
- ✓ All sections of the NSDCAC Scholarship Application must be completed with accompanying documents and be postmarked by March 29, 2019. Completed application packets will be

screened and evaluated by the scholarship committee. Note: Late scholarship application submissions will <u>not</u> be accepted past the postmarked date.

- ✓ Incomplete applications will not be evaluated nor returned for completion.
- ✓ Scholarship winners of the North San Diego County Alumnae Chapter will be notified by U.S. Postal mail by May 3, 2019.
- ✓ Scholarship recipients must verify college/university enrollment by having their college Registrar's Office send the signed copy of the Enrollment Verification Form to:
