The Middle Class Scholarship (MCS) is a program that provides a tuition discount to undergraduate students attending University of California (UC) or California State University (CSU) campuses as well as teaching credential programs.

How do I qualify?

To **qualify**, students need to:

- Be U.S. citizens, permanent residents or have AB 540 student status
- Attend a UC or CSU campus as an undergraduate or a teaching credential program
- Be enrolled in 6 or more units
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress and satisfy all outstanding requirements requested by the school
- Meet certain income, asset, and other financial aid standards
- Not be in default on a student loan
- Not be incarcerated
- Have less than 40% of mandatory university fees covered by federal, state, and/or institutional grants
- Complete the FAFSA or CA Dream Act application by the March 2 deadline

What do I get with a Middle Class Scholarship?

If your family earns:

Up to \$100,000 per year. You may be eligible for a tuition discount, of up to \$3,690 at a UC or \$1,644 at a CSU, of the mandatory 2016-17 systemwide tuition and fees.

Between \$100,001 and \$150,000 per year. You may be eligible for a tuition discount, of around \$2,250 at a UC and \$1,000 at a CSU, of the mandatory 2016-17 systemwide tuition and fees.
