- **First Year Experience (FYE) Presentation and Application Workshop**

 - Description: Mt. San Jacinto College's First Year Experience (FYE) Program is designed to make sure students have a smooth transition into college life. We provide first year students with extra support during their first two semesters, so they connect with the college and identify a degree path that leads to faster degree completion or transfer. As a result, students in FYE are more likely to persist to their second year than their fellow-peers. FYE students have access to early registration, MSJC Promise Program eligibility, Summer Bridge, and FYE counselors/mentors.
