CAWG Foundation Scholarships

The California Association of Winegrape Growers Foundation is offering at least six scholarships in **2021** to graduating high school seniors. Students may study the subject of their choice.

CAWG Foundation is awarding two types of scholarships: 1) Three \$8,000 scholarships for four years at any campus in the University of California or California State University system. **2)** Three \$2,000 scholarships for two years at any California community college.

Students may forfeit their scholarship eligibility and/or award for any of the follow-ing reasons:

- Enrollment in less than 12 units per semester
- Grades that drop below 2.0 in any given semester
- Providing false or misleading educational or eligibility information
- Any form of plagiarism

In addition, the CAWG Foundation reserves the right to withdraw a scholarship at any time if the conditions of the scholarship or the CAWG Foundation policies are violated.

Who May Apply

Only the children with a parent or legal guardian employed by a California vineyard during the **2020 - 2021** winegrape growing season are eligible to apply. Children with a parent or guardian who is a winegrape grower may request a waiver from this eligibility requirement based upon financial need. To qualify for waiver consideration, a letter demonstrating financial need must be submitted with the completed application packet. Children of current directors or employees of the **CAWG Foundation** are not eligible to apply.

You must be a high school senior graduating in **2021**. Students currently enrolled in college are not eligible.

The Selection Process

The Board of the California Association of Winegrape Growers Foundation will award the scholarships. Selection is based upon the following criteria: • Financial need

- Demonstrated scholastic ability
- Community involvement and leadership and/or work employment.
 Community involvement, leadership, and/or work history is a broad category that assumes one or a combination of the following:
 - Community service;
 - Employment where the student is making a contribution to the California economy which may not allow time for community service;
 - Sports participation with the understanding that these activities build character and leadership skills, teach strategic and analytical thinking and promote goal setting and teamwork.

Your determination to succeed

• 500 word essay

To qualify for the scholarships, students must:

- •Be graduating from high school and plan to attend a University of California, California State University or California community college in the fall of **2021**;
- Have a parent or legal guardian who is/was an employee of a <u>Winegrape</u> grower during the **2020** or **2021** season;
- Complete the application form;
- Attach official high school transcript;
- Optional to attach a copy of your SAT or ACT results if you are applying for a four-year scholarship; SAT or ACT results are not required for the 2021 scholarship;
- Provide a letter of recommendation from an <u>instructor</u>, the <u>school principal</u> or <u>counselor</u>. The letter must be signed and provide the address, telephone number and position held in the school.
- Submit a 500 word essay that tells the committee about you, your financial need, your career goals, and how

you plan to help your community. Addressing some or all of the following questions and statements below may assist you in writing your essay, but addressing these specific questions and statements is not required to complete the essay.

- Tell us about your family relationships and financial need.
- Is attending college common in your family?
- Why do you want to continue your education?
- Tell us about your extracurricular activities, community service and any work experience you may have.
- How will this scholarship make a difference in your continued education?
- What accomplishments are you most proud of?
- What are your career goals and estimated timelines to achieve these goals?
- How do you plan to give back to your community?
