The Riverside Sheriffs' Association and Riverside County Deputy Sheriff Relief Foundation established this scholarship program to assist members' children and students from Riverside County, California high schools.

Who May Apply?

Applicants must be high school seniors or undergraduates who plan to attend or are currently enrolled in a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited two- or four-year college or university, vocational-technical or trade school in the United States for the entire academic year who are:

- U.S. Citizens,
- Dependent children of active or retired regular or affiliate members of the Riverside Sheriffs' Association, or
- High school seniors currently attending, graduates or undergraduates that have attended a Riverside County, California high school.

Four (4) awards of \$2,500 will be granted to students who plan to attend or currently attending an accredited four-year college or university.

Four (4) awards of \$1,000 will be granted to students who plan to attend or currently attending an accredited two-year college, vocational-technical or trade school.

Financial need will be considered in the selection of scholarship recipients.
