Semester membership is based on work done in the previous semester (under very limited circumstances summer school may be used; you should check with your advisor before listing any summer school work)

If you qualify for 4 semesters, you will graduate as a CSF member (one semester must be in the senior year)
 If you qualify for 6 semesters, you will graduate as a lifetime CSF member (one semester must be in the senior year)

To qualify for CSF membership this semester, follow these guidelines:

You must earn a *minimum of 10 points* from last semester's grades.

- The first 4 points must be from LIST I
- The first seven points (including the 4 described above) must be from LISTS I AND II.
- The remaining points may come from any LIST.

2. You must use *no more than 5* courses to qualify.
3. No CSF points are given for physical education, courses taken in lieu of physical education, subjects repeated to improve a grade, courses involving clerking and office/teaching assisting and courses taken on a pass/fail basis.
4. CSF points are granted as follows:
 - a grade of A = 3 CSF points
 - a grade of B = 1 CSF point
 One additional point shall be granted for a grade of A or B in an AP course, up to a maximum of two such points per semester.
 - a grade of C = 0 points
 - a grade of D or F in any course, even in one you cannot use to qualify, disqualifies you from membership at this time.

Note: More points are given for courses under the auspices of a college; check with your advisor for exact number.

You must re-apply each semester; Dues are paid by \$10 donation each semester at bookkeeper window
