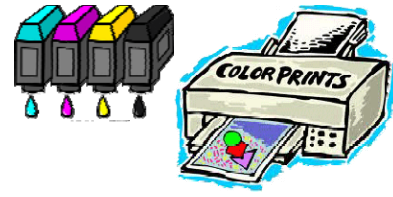
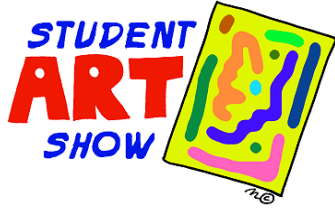


BE A PART OF MVHS ART!



Dear Parents and Guardians,

WE WELCOME YOUR STUDENT to the MVHS Art department! During this yearlong course, students will create a variety of graphic design projects. The teacher will print out a selection of student artworks which will be displayed in the classroom, at exhibits, open house art walk and in the school office throughout the school year. Students will also learn new techniques, expand knowledge of software programs, build graphics vocabulary, and explore careers in the arts.

These graphic art projects are printed and mounted with "consumable" supplies which cannot be reused such as: ink cartridges/toners, printing papers, mounting boards, lamination film and portfolio supplies. As expenses rise and budgets recede, we humbly rely on generous DONATIONS* to help defray the cost of supplies. If you are interested in supporting the MVHS Visual Arts Program you may do so by making a **CASH** donation anytime during the school year to your son/daughters art instructor. ***DONATIONS** The California Constitution requires that public education be provided to students free of charge, unless a charge is specifically authorized by law for a particular program or activity. Therefore, the Murrieta Valley School District may not charge fees for school programs and extracurricular activities, except for those programs or activities where a fee is specifically authorized by law. The fees, charges, and deposits that are legally authorized by law include, but are not limited to *Visual Arts Materials*. The California Constitution allows school districts to request voluntary donations and engage in fundraising activities and programs. These donations and fundraising financial contributions are voluntary, and all students will be allowed to participate in school activities and extracurricular activities regardless of whether the parent or legal guardian makes a donation or contribution.
