

GD3 Students - Display Boards

- Use only one side of the white foam-core board I left out for you.
- Obviously pick the good side.
- Ask the sub for the museum putty to hang your art with. Don't use tape unless you absolutely need to, it damages the boards. If the putty is not working for you, use tape. Read the directions of the museum putty or ask Mrs. Weaver if you are not sure how it works.
- Be sure to watch margins and spacing. Don't put anything directly to the edges or touching each other.
- Make sure you have your name on the display board and all artwork is labeled. You can always ask a GD2 student if you are not sure how to do it.
- Complete the CSUSM board as well.
- When you are finished, place the boards back where you got them.
