OPPORTUNITIES FOR INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE STUDENTS AT GCU

Grand Canyon University offers generous scholarship opportunities to qualified students. Beginning in 2014, any student graduating with an International Baccalaureate (IB) diploma is eligible for our **Chancellor scholarship***, valued at up to \$12,000 per year for students living on campus.

As a graduate of an IB program, you are:

- Automatically qualified for our Chancellor scholarship, regardless of GPA or SAT/ACT scores
- Automatically accepted into the Honors Institute
- Eligible to transfer credits from IB test scores

PROGRAMME EXAMINATION CREDIT

Students who enroll at Grand Canyon University may receive credit for IB exams as shown in the table. Students may transfer a total of 30 credits from all alternative transfer credit options (such as AP, IB and CLEP) combined. The application of credit toward your degree will depend upon IB exam scores, other potential transfer credits submitted to the university and your intended program of study. Please speak to an admissions representative to find out how your IB exam credit will count toward your proposed degree program.
