
Multiple Invites


☐ Each department has priority days. Students should still communicate with teachers if they receive multiple invites and establish plans on meeting with them.

Student Procedures

Student Procedures and Expectations

- ☐ Scheduled invites will be emailed to you.

 CHECK YOUR EMAIL/ CANVAS DAILY!
- ☐ You may only go to one of your teachers. Sign up with a teacher ahead of time (by Wednesday latest) to avoid being late. Have a 2nd and 3rd choice already established in case your 1st choice class is full.
- ☐ Be sure to check-in by scanning the teacher's QR code
- ☐ Students need to use the 5-minute passing period to get from their "home stables" (period 1 or 2) to another class.
- ☐ Students should be doing an activity that enhances or enriches their academics. It is not "free time".



Attendance and Discipline



- ☐ Passing period is from 9:01-9:06am. Students have 5 minutes to be in a classroom.
- ☐ Break is AFTER office hours
- ☐ Any stray or late broncos roaming around will receive a detention / Saturday school.
- ☐ Attendance will be monitored so be sure to check in via the teacher's QR code

CLASS ACT BRONCOS

- ☐ Students with a 4.0 higher have the option to travel to a designated area on campus outside of a classroom (library or quad area)
- ☐ GPAs will be checked every 6 week grading period
- ☐ A sticker will be given to place on ID card for the grading period. Save it for that triad, as that can act as your pass to be outside of the classroom.
- ☐ These students will need to check in with an ID. No ID will result in being sent back to a classroom.



CLASS ACT BRONCOS

- ☐ Class Act Broncos will need to form a line in front of an administrator (stationed around the quad lunch tables and outside of library)
- ☐ Have your IDs ready! You will be scanned for check-in. No ID= No check in
- ☐ You must stay in your designated areas (library/ quad). No roaming around the campus.
