## **Cap & Gown and other graduation ceremony info:**

It is our sincere hope we are able to provide a traditional commencement ceremony at the conclusion of this school year in accordance with all public health guidelines. If we are unable to do so, we will provide a virtual event and photo opportunities including graduation gowns and regalia. Once we can confirm the nature of this ceremony, we will communicate information regarding graduation tickets, event parking, and any other details relevant to this event.

Vista Murrieta High School is working with Herff Jones as our vendor for graduation products and other high school memorabilia such as class rings. All graduates participating in our commencement ceremony will be asked to wear a cap, gown, stole and tassel. Students will continue to have the option to select either blue or white cap and gown. For those students who wish to purchase this cap and gown unit to keep, the cost will be \$60 plus tax. Students may also elect to borrow a cap and gown unit but must return the unit prior to receiving their diploma.

**Mid-level yearbook pricing** - \$90 for all - Jan 1<sup>st</sup>-\*29<sup>th</sup> (from bookkeeper or online at Jostens.com for everyone).

**Final yearbook pricing** - \$100 for all - Jan 30<sup>th</sup> until books sell out.

**\*WE WILL SELL OUT! Guarantee your book and purchase before January 29<sup>th</sup>, otherwise, you may not get one. Supplies will be very limited this year.**

**Senior Formal Cap and Gown Pictures:** Seniors need to take a formal senior photo with our partners at **Studio 94** prior to Jan 10<sup>th</sup>. This is the last day to take photos and still get them in the yearbook. Contact Studio 94 ASAP to set up an appointment. The yearbook photo for your school is a head and shoulders photo. In the past, Studio 94 has used their tuxes and drapes as the standard required attire. Due to social distancing policies, we are suspending the use of tuxes and drapes for the yearbook photo this year. We have developed new wardrobe requirements for the yearbook photo so that we maintain a high standard of appearance. The new required attire will be a black or dark shirt or top. We cannot allow t-shirts or shirts with messages on them.

### **Yearbook Distribution**

Due to COVID-19 and a lack of activities during the fall and early part of winter, VMHS has pushed back the distribution date of all 2021 yearbooks to the summer of 2021 (mid-to-late JULY) to ensure that we have enough time to get more of the Winter and all possible Spring events in before having to submit the book to the publisher for the six-week turnaround time. Although we understand this may be frustrating to many, it is our goal as a staff and publication to make sure we do our best to provide quality coverage of as many events and activities as possible. Once we determine the actual distribution date, notification will be sent out.

As a means of giving students who purchased a yearbook something to get signed while still in school, we will distribute autograph sections to each student near the end of the school year so that they may still get the signatures and then be able to attach the signature pages into the book itself later. We appreciate your understanding and hope that this delay provides us with the opportunity to include as much as we can, up to, and including graduation coverage.

### **THE FOLLOWING POLICIES PERTAIN TO ALL DANCES:**

**Guest Passes for All Dances** are mandatory for guests of VMHS students who do not attend school at Vista Murrieta. Only one guest is allowed per student. Guests must be of high school age, and no individual over the age of 20 years old will be allowed. Guests 18 – 20 years old must include a copy of their driver’s license or legal California ID card attached to their guest pass. Guest passes must be picked up at the Trading Post or Bookkeeper and returned with payment to the bookkeeper.

**School ID cards are mandatory for admission to all dances.**

**\*\*All students and guests MUST have a photo I.D.\*\***

**No-Go Policy:** Vista Murrieta High School plans activities and events for students in the spirit of equity and inclusion to connect all students to our campus community. Prior to ticket sales opening for a particular dance, a No-Go list will be posted in the Student Support office. A student may be placed on the No-Go list for one of the following reasons:

- 2 or more Ds or any Fs in core classes required for graduation

- GPA below 2.0
- Excessive absences, tardies or truancies
- Major discipline issues
- Outstanding library books or outstanding debt.

We have found the No-Go list to be an effective motivational tool to encourage struggling students to seek guidance and/or intervention. While a student may be initially placed on the No-Go list, our ultimate goal is to support these students and help them identify concrete steps to improve their grades, their behavior and/or their attendance. Should students find themselves on the No-Go list, we encourage all of these students to meet with their counselor in order to develop an action plan. Some of these steps may include meeting with their teachers, attending tutoring sessions, attending Broncotutorials on Saturdays, improved attendance or improved behavior. The No-Go list is not intended to be punitive, but the first step in struggling students getting the support they need. We want all students to be eligible to attend school dances and other events.

### **Disneyland Grad Nite:**

Disneyland has cancelled all high school Class of 2021 Grad Nite festivities. As the health and safety guidelines for the end of the year become more clear, we will plan end of the year events accordingly to celebrate the Class of 2021.
