

Vista Murrieta High School Student Parking Information

Student and parent or guardian are to read each paragraph below. Both shall initial to acknowledge that they have both read and understand each statement

Student / Parent Initial

____ / ____

Parking for students is available at our school site. Although the District is providing parking in designated areas, the District and/or VMHS assumes no responsibility for the loss, theft or damage to any vehicle. In order to park on VMHS premises the following regulations MUST be adhered to.

____ / ____

Student parking on campus is by PERMIT ONLY. Parking is at your own risk. Fill out the Vehicle Registration form at the bottom of this notice and submit it with a copy of the *Student's Driver's License* and return to the bookkeeper's window.

____ / ____

There will be a **\$20.00** charge for a Parking Permit. Additional permits for a second car, replacement permits, lost or damaged permits will **\$25.00**.

____ / ____

Cars MUST be parked in designated stalls ONLY. Students are to be in the parking lot only when arriving or leaving school. DO NOT store books, clothing or other items which may be needed during school in your car. You will not be allowed to go to your car during the school day. For emergency situations, report to the security office for assistance.

____ / ____

No student parking will be available in designated STAFF parking stalls at any time.

____ / ____

Students violating any parking policy may receive a parking citation. (See student handbook and/or attached parking regulations for reference). Parking citation fines are paid to an outside agency listed on the citation. Failure to pay the fine may result in increased penalties and a report to the DMV. Violation include but are not limited to: failure to properly display a parking permit on the rearview mirror or dash; parking in reserved stalls; blocking vehicles, traffic lanes, ramps or sidewalks.

____ / ____

It is the student's responsibility to arrive at school with enough time to find a parking stall. In the event that the lots are filled to capacity, the student may legally park on the white curbs located in the parking lots. Both tires must be within 18 inches from the curb. The vehicle cannot block traffic, parked cars, ramps, reserved stalls, "no" parking spaces nor sidewalks.

____ / ____

If a student accidently causes damage to any vehicle on school premises, by law the student must leave correct contact information on the damaged vehicle. Hit and Run Violations are a crime and will result in revoked or suspended parking privileges. And can result in a report filed with the Murrieta Police Department. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED FOR REVOKED PARKING PERMITS**

Vista Murrieta High School **Parking Program and Regulations**

To ensure student and staff safety and to prevent unauthorized vehicles from parking on our campus, Vista Murrieta High School has implemented a parking program. All vehicles parking at VMHS MUST have a valid VMHS Parking Permit, which has been obtained through the Bookkeeper's Office. Temporary or one-day passes will not be given to students at any time.

Parking is at your own risk!

Visitors MUST obtain a one-day pass from campus security located in the guard shack located in the parking lot.

0100-Parking Permit Not Visible

Every vehicle parked in any of the VMHS parking lots, will be required to have a valid VMHS Parking Permit, which has been obtained at the Bookkeeper's Office. Parking in one of the parking lots at VMHS without obtaining a permanent VMHS parking permit and making sure it is visible, is in accordance with Violation 0200 and could result in receiving a ticket with a \$35.00 fine.

0200-Parking Permit Not Properly Displayed

Every vehicle parking in any parking lot on the VMHS campus MUST possess a Parking Permit in accordance with Violation 0100.

- Parking Permits MUST be hung from the rear view mirror, with the permit information facing forward. It is a violation to not properly display the Parking Permit and make it clearly visible and could result in receiving a ticket with a \$35.00 fine.
- One-day visitor passes MUST be placed on the front, inside passenger side windshield. It is a violation to not properly display the visitor pass and make it clearly visible and could result in receiving a ticket with \$35.00 fine.

0300-Not Properly Parking in Parking Stall

Each vehicle that parks in any VMHS parking area MUST have the front of the vehicle leading into the marked stall - DO NOT BACK IN. Each stall will be clearly marked enabling the driver to know where the vehicle is to be parked. It is a violation to not have your vehicle facing into the parking stall, and could result in receiving a ticket with a \$35.00 fine.

0400-Not Parked in Designated Lot

VMHS parking is as follows:

- One student parking lot located off of Clinton Keith Rd., thru the main school parking entrance (adjacent to the track).
- Visitor parking located off of Clinton Keith Rd., thru the main school parking entrance (in front of the Gymnasium & Administration Building).
- Two staff parking lots; one located off of Clinton Keith Rd., thru the main school parking entrance (in front of the Administration Building) and one off of Whitewood (east of the school complex). These lots are exclusively designated "reserved" parking only.

It is a violation for students to park in areas other than designated "student parking" and could result in receiving a ticket and a \$35.00 fine.

Please Note: Students with 5 truancies in a semester will have their parking Privileges revoked for the remainder of the year.
