

- File the Better FAFSA, priority given to those who file by March 2





- Review your student's transcript. Generally, your student should have a total of 140 credits, if they are in good standing for graduation. If less than that, plan on Summer School enrollment for credit recovery.
- Complete your Junior Reflective Task (JRT) when assigned in the Spring. The JRT
 is part of the requirements for graduation. There will be more information given
 to Juniors in the Spring regarding this requirement.

11TH GRADE FOCUS



- Discuss the option of taking the SAT or ACT in the Spring as an additional way to determine if you are ready for college –
- Do your best on the Smarter Balanced Summative Assessment Your CAASPP EAP results will help determine if you are ready for college level courses before attending college. In addition to, student will be tested on Science as well. Results will be posted on student's transcript.
- Take the ASVAB if military bound or interested in an additional career assessment

WHY TAKE THE PSAT?

PSAT helps students determine what they need to work on most so that you're ready for college when you graduate from high school. It also tests the same skills and knowledge as the SAT. The PSAT also identifies AP courses that you have a good chance of passing with a 3 or higher on an AP exam.
