

# MVUSD ELEMENTARY COVID-19 NOTIFICATIONS STUDENT QUARANTINE BEST PRACTICES

SCENARIOS BASED ON EACH STUDENT'S UNIQUE CIRCUMSTANCES

## ASYMPTOMATIC (NO SYMPTOMS)



**VACCINATED**

**MAY CONTINUE TO ATTEND SCHOOL**

**AND**

Participate in SEED, co-curriculars and extra-curricular activities

**AS LONG AS**

Student is symptom free meaning student is not exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms or any signs of illness.



**UNVACCINATED**

**Modified Quarantine recommendations:**

**CONTINUE TO ATTEND SCHOOL**

**AS LONG AS**

Student is symptom free meaning, they are not showing any signs of illness or of COVID-19

**AND**

Continues to wear a mask at school

**AND**

Tests for COVID on day 5 after exposure

**AND**

Abstains from co-curriculars and activities.

## SYMPTOMATIC SHOWING SIGNS OF ILLNESS



**VACCINATED & UNVACCINATED**

**STAY HOME**

**SELF-ISOLATE - 5 days**

**TAKE A COVID TEST**

**IF TEST IS NEGATIVE,**  
Student may return when symptoms have resolved

**AND**

Student **has not had** a fever for 24 hours without the use of fever relieving medication

**IF TEST IS POSITIVE**

Student stay home for 5 days

**AND**

Test again on Day 5 from the onset of symptoms

**IF test is negative student may return to school on day 6.**

Email notifications are sent to all students who have a positive COVID-19 case in their class.



## STUDENT COVID-19 TESTING

PCR and Antigen Testing is available at each school site. Please visit your school website or newsletter for testing schedule and instructions on how to register.

The State is providing at-home antigen test for each MVUSD student. If you have not picked up your students tests, please contact your students school.
