Contest Guidelines:

- * Entries must be turned in on 8.5 X 11 sheet of white paper no lines and vertical orientation
- *Must include the words "Alta Murrieta Elementary School" and school year "2017-2018"
- *Be a theme of your choice!
- *Use bright bold colors (no pencil)
- *Can include your interpretation of our school mascot, the Mustang
- *Can include the words "AltaRocks"
- * Student's name must be written on the back lightly in pencil; permission slip must be filled out and turned in with artwork. (NO STAPLES)
- *Be creative, be neat, do your best, and have fun!
- *All artwork MUST be turned in to your teacher on or before December 8th.

Tips to creating a picture-perfect design:

- **Rich Colors** – The more depth and contrast in your artwork, the better! Dark colors placed next to each other will not reproduce well.
- **Thick Lines** – make sure outlines are thick. Use markers to outline.
- **Careful with Crayons** – If using crayons, be sure the color is crisp and not too subtle. Light shading with crayons may not reproduce.
- **Metallics and Fluorescents** – Glitter, metallic, and fluorescent colors do not reproduce well when printed and should be avoided.
