Service	<i>This committee shall have responsibility for devising at least one major service project annually, other than international, which shall involve all or most of the membership.</i>	November CHILI COOK-OFF @ VMHS; 2009 Relay for Life @ Murrieta;
Finance	<i>This committee shall devise ways and means of financing any and all club activities requiring funds, in cooperation with the appropriate committee.</i>	Continuous fundraising to support club events and major activities sponsored by the Service Committee; T-shirt sale; Scholarships
Club	<i>This committee shall be responsible for attendance, membership, programs, fellowship, public relations and such other matters as may be deemed appropriate.</i>	Membership database; School CLUB RUSH registration and CLUB SERVICE RUSH (Committee sign-ups); Information and Communication of Interact Club's Regular Membership meetings; Publicity & Public Relations; Club Banquets for Awarding of Certificates for Active Membership; Senior Send-off
