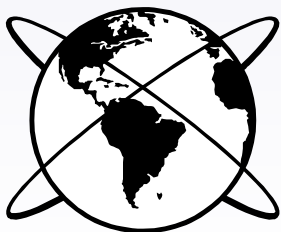


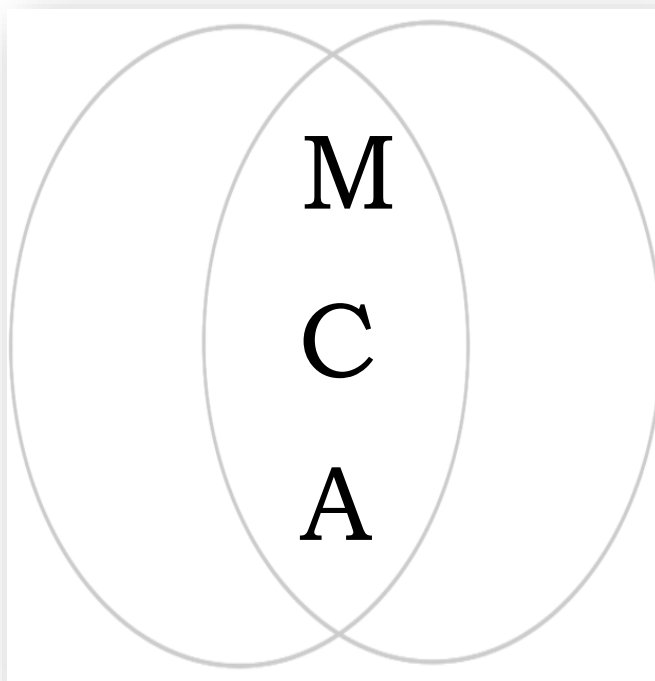
School Mission/Vision

Elementary

Independent Study Program

- ◆ Students attend on a satellite campus.

- ◆ Uses Odysseyware Online and MVUSD approved curriculum.
- ◆ Learning whereby students get immediate feedback.

Middle School

Independent Study Program

High School

Daily Program

- ◆ 6 class periods of semester-paced instruction from teachers
- ◆ Students who desire a smaller learning environment
- ◆ Students who are credit deficient and desire to remediate for returning to the comprehensive high school
- ◆ Students who prefer a lower teacher/student ratio
- ◆ Bussing is available through transportation
- ◆ Opportunity to accelerate
- ◆ Student Advisory period with teacher

Hybrid Program

- ◆ Courses available with face to face instruction 2X a week blended with independent study

Independent Study Program

- ◆ All courses are UC/CSU approved
- ◆ Students are able to work independently with the opportunity to accelerate
- ◆ Most high school curriculum is APEX Online Learning whereby students get immediate feedback.
- ◆ Flexible school hours that allow students to pursue short or long term goals
- ◆ Access to a master teacher with lower teacher/student ratios
- ◆ Students are able to participate in extra-curricular activities and CIF sports if they are co-enrolled in at least two courses at the comprehensive schools
- ◆ Co-enrolled senior students are able to participate in senior activities at both schools and have the option to walk at both Graduation ceremonies
