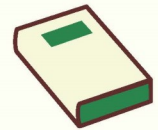

Advanced Placement NEWS!

Welcome Back, AP Students and Families! Please be aware of the to-do items for this fall! Details for how to complete these tasks and their deadlines will be coming soon! Watch your email and this newsletter!

- 1. Add your current AP class(es) to your College Board account using the Join Code(s) that you will get from your teacher(s). Each period has a unique Join Code.**
- 2. Plan ahead to pay for your exams! Each exam is \$101; AP Capstone Exams (for AP Seminar and AP Research) are \$151. Payments will be due this fall by early November. All payments will be handled through Total Registration again this year.**
 - a. If you are eligible for the National School Lunch Program, please make sure to complete a new application as soon as possible. If you qualify, you will be able to use a Fee Waiver to pay \$5 per exam; using a Fee Waiver requires that you take the exam or you will be charged the cancellation fee, which was \$40 last year.**

Please remember to watch your email account, this newsletter, and the announcements for important details coming soon. If you have questions, please contact Mrs. Amstutz (lamstutz@murrieta.k12.ca.us) or Ms. Kim (ckim@murrieta.k12.ca.us).
