## **Greek 10 Definitions**

**antipathy** (antihpuhthee) the object of a feeling of intense aversion; something to be avoided

apathy (apuhthee) an absence of emotion or enthusiasm; indifference

bibliophile someone who loves (and usually collects) books

empathy (EHmpuhthee) understanding and entering into another's feelings

**hemophilia** (heemuhfeeleeuh) congenital tendency to uncontrolled bleeding; usually affects males and is transmitted from mother to son

**pathogen** (pathuhjuhn) any disease-producing agent (especially a virus or bacterium or other microorganism)

**philanthropist** (fuhlanthruhpuhst) someone who makes charitable donations intended to increase human well-being

**philosopher** (fuhlosuhfur) a wise person who is calm and rational; someone who lives a life of reason with equanimity

psychopath (siikohpath) a person with an antisocial personality disorder

**telepathy** (tuhlEHpuhthee) apparent communication from one mind to another without using sensory perceptions
