neophobia a morbid fear of novelty

phonics (fnks) teaching reading by training beginners to associate letters with their sound values

triskaidekaphobia a morbid fear of the number 13

xenophobia (znfohb) an irrational fear of foreigners or strangers

zoophobia a morbid fear of animals
